
# Academic Programs

#### Proposed Program Modality Definitions


- **1. Face-to-Face:** The program is limited to a set location, where instructor and students can engage in traditional interaction.
- 2. F2F+ (Remote Access): The program is accessible via a blend of courses that may include some face-to-face classes in some locations, remote access courses, low-residency labs, and/or online courses. Remote access classes for students not in the face-to-face classroom occurs through a video conferencing platform such as Zoom or a secondary connected "telepresence" classroom.
- **3. Low-Residency**: The program offers flexibility for working adults via opportunities for low-residency face-to-face access, for example for lab courses, at a campus location paired with online or remote access learning.
- **4. Online:** The program offers access via online courses backed by a full array of virtual services and supports, with a potential blend of synchronous and asynchronous course components.
