

Student Advisory Council Feedback – Student and Residence Life

Residence Life Concept Design:

- Four options: traditional residential, low-residency, hybrid/family housing
- Professional and student live-in student staff at each location
- Central administration separated into 1. Residential Education and 2. Housing Operations

Model 1: Traditional Housing

- Full academic term
- Meal plan required
- Campus location depending on major
- Could also potentially choose campus for certain reasons (sports, close to where they work etc.)
- Should it be required first two years under 21?

Model 2: Low Residency Housing

- Not full academic term
- Flexible housing based on student need and academic program requirements
- Could be one day, one week, one month etc.
- Meal plan optional

Model 3: Hybrid Housing

- Longer-term housing, up to full academic term
- Additional services like meal plan may not required
- Kitchen facilities would be needed

Model 4: Family and or Apartment Housing

- 12 month apartment-style housing
- Available for married couples and/or dependent children
- Meal plan optional

Counseling and Health Services

- Campus-based physical health services
- Campus-based mental health services
- Telehealth services

New Student Onboarding (Orientation/FYE)

- In-person campus orientation
- Online orientation
- First-year experience

Student Activities/Government/Clubs

- Governance structure for campuses and VSU
- Student Activity fees
- Support a hybrid campus with activities and clubs
