



CCV Modalities and VTSU Proposed Modalities

Modality in the academic context refers to how students are able to attend the class.

Proposed VTSU Modalities Definitions

- In-Person: A course limited to a set location, where the instructor and students can interact in-person.
- In-Person Plus: A course where students have two options for how to engage in synchronous class meetings: by attending class inperson or by attending class remotely via Zoom.
- Hybrid: This course is split between course meetings, held at designated times, and online interactions. In some instances, students may be able to choose whether they attend in-person or remotely.



- **Hyflex:** A course where students have several options for how to engage with class meetings: by attending class in-person, by attending class remotely, or by using lectures and materials uploaded by the instructor to attend asynchronously.
- Online Asynchronous: This course is offered fully online. Students
 work asynchronously and the course has set assignment due
 dates.
- Remote Synchronous: This course is offered synchronously with class meetings delivered over a video conferencing platform on specified days and times.




- Remote Hybrid: This course is delivered remotely in a manner which combines remote synchronous and asynchronous online coursework. Students attend synchronous course meetings over a video conferencing platform on specified days and times.
- **Telepresense:** This course is offered in a room outfitted with telepresence technology at a set location on specified days and times. Students attend the course in-person with the instructor on one campus while other students attend in a classroom outfitted with telepresence technology at another campus.



CCV's Modalities Definitions

- Online courses take place 100% online via Canvas, without required in-person or Zoom meetings.
- In Person courses meet in person at CCV centers, typically once each week for the duration of the semester.
- Accelerated courses provide the same content and the same number of credits as standard courses but are delivered in a condensed time frame.





- Hybrid courses combine online instruction with limited in-person meetings throughout the semester.
- FLEX courses are online courses with flexible assignment submission, allowing students to manage their completion pace during the semester.
- Synchronous courses are delivered through a combination of online and regularlyscheduled Zoom sessions. In synchronous classes, students must attend Zoom sessions and actively engage with each other and faculty in course activities and discussions.


