#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Neither parent (biological, or adoptive) has a four-year degree or higher OR
- · Your family has a low to modest income (according to TRIO quidelines) **OR**
- You have a documented disability according to the Americans with Disabilities Act

## SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT AID

Students who participate in the Summer Bridge program are given priority in the selection for Supplemental Grant Aid. Students may earn up to \$5,000 in the Spring 2024 semester by meeting eligibility requirements, such as:

- Successful completion of Summer Bridge
- Regular meetings with TRIO or Academic Support staff in Fall 2023
- · Fall 2023 GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Receipt of a federal Pell Grant in Fall 2023
- The Castleton campus requires an additional application in Fall 2023.
